SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS
CHAPTER 1 - STANDARD REQUIREMENTS

1.1 Event Title and Date

The event shall be known as the Autotrader Trophy to be held on 13 April 2008.

1.2 Organisation and Status

- a) The event shall be held under the International Sporting Code of the Federation Internationale de l'automobile (FIA), the National Competition Rules (NCR) of Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Ltd (CAMS), the Race Meeting Standing Regulations, the WASCC Standing Regulations, these Regulations and any amendments, and any Further Regulations and instructions to competitors that may be issued. These Regulations must be read in conjunction with the WASCC Standing Regulations which may be obtained from the WASCC website at www.wascc.com.au, or by contacting the office on 9306 8022.
- b) This event will be conducted in accordance with the CAMS Risk Management & Occupational Health and Safety Policies. These policies are available from the CAMS website www.cams.com.au
- c) The event shall be a State Championship Race Meeting.

- f) Acceptance and Oversubscribed Entries: Entries shall be accepted in order of receipt. Where entries exceed the track density for the category entered, the competitors will be given the option to remain on the list as reserve entries, in the event that another

competitor withdraws. Competitors who do not accept this option will receive a full refund of the entry fee paid.

- g) The Organisers reserve the right to refuse entry in accordance with NCR 83.

Length: Long Circuit 2.42 kilometres. Direction: Clockwise. Surface: Asphalt

1.6 Official's Sign On and Senior Officials Briefing

The Race Office opens at 0700 hrs for officials to sign on. Flag Marshals sign on at the Flag Marshal's garage. Scrutineers sign on at the Scrutiny Bay at 0700 hrs. **All Senior Officials or team representative are required to attend a briefing in the Media Centre at 0730 hrs.**

1.7 Log Book Lodgement and Apparel Check

The Scrutiny Office opens at 0810 hrs for competitors to lodge their log books with the Scrutineers and have their apparel checked at the times below. Those drivers who had their apparel checked during a pre season audit will not need to present their apparel again, unless requested. No vehicle is permitted to practice or race unless it has passed a 2008 Pre Season Audit.

0810 – 0820 hrs	Formula Vees and HQ Holdens
0820 – 0840 hrs	Street Cars and Improved Production Cars and Formula Fords
0840 – 0900 hrs	Saloon Cars
0900 – 0915 hrs	Historic Touring Cars and Production Sports Cars

Where a vehicle has a notation in the log book, the vehicle must be presented at the scrutiny bay prior to log book lodgement.

Drivers must hold at a minimum a Provisional Circuit (PC) Licence. Provisional licences will be held and can be collected from the Race Office at the conclusion of the meeting. All drivers holding PC licences must have displayed a 'P' plate on the rear of their vehicle in accordance with Schedule K. Those who do not may be penalised by the Stewards.

1.10 Auto Trader Trophy Handicap Eligible Competitors

The fastest three qualifiers for Saloon Cars (AU/VT), fastest three qualifiers for Saloon Cars (EA/VN), fastest six qualifiers for Street Cars and fastest six qualifiers for Improved Production Cars are eligible to compete in the Auto Trader Trophy Handicap Race. The Handicapper may include other vehicles at their discretion should one or more of the 18 eligible competitors are unable to compete.

1.11 Guinness Book of World Records attempt for the "Largest Parade of Subaru Vehicles"

A parade of Subaru vehicles will be conducted at approximately 1210 hrs during the Officials Lunch Break. Drivers will be briefed by the Clerk of Course or his representative before taking part. Vehicles will enter the circuit via the north ramp (opposite ramp to racing) and proceed behind the safety car for a lap at a speed not exceeding 30 kph. Vehicles will exit the circuit via the pit lane and north ramp. Passengers are permitted inside the vehicle. Vehicles may not drop back and accelerate up to the car in front at any time. Any breach may incur eviction from the venue and or further penalty as imposed by Stewards or the Clerk of Course.

1.12 Prohibited Substances

During any event, consumption of alcoholic beverages in the paddock, pits or any other portion of the competition venue under the control of the officials is expressly forbidden until all practice or competition activity is concluded for each day. Any driver or crew member who is found to be affected by alcohol on the day of the event or practice therefore shall not be permitted to participate. Refer NCR 145A of the Current CAMS Manual.

In addition, the persons concerned will be subject to the Articles of the Procedure for Alcohol Testing and CAMS Drugs in Sport Policy. Competitors, crews or officials may be tested for alcohol or other drugs at any time during the event(s). This regulation serves as the required 24-hour notice to Competitors, Crew and Officials.

1.13 Protests

Competitors are reminded of their right to protest in accordance with Part XII of the Current CAMS Manual.

1.14 Postponement, Abandonment or Cancellation

The Organisers reserve the right to postpone, abandon or cancel the event in accordance with NCR 59.

1.15 Insurance
