

# **WA Sporting Car Club 2011 Standing Regulations Bulletin 1**

## **1 Improved Production Cars**

### **1.1 State Championship for Improved Production Cars**

*Replaces WASCC Standing Regulation 3.1.4*

Points for each race will be accumulated and the winner of each class will be the driver with the highest aggregate of points.

### **1.2 Improved Production Cars Up to 2000cc Point Score**

*Replaces WASCC Standing Regulation 2 – only for Improved Production Cars*

Points for any Meeting or Series or Championship shall be allocated to the driver for each race that comprises of that Meeting or Series or Championship as follows: 1st – 25 points, 2nd – 22, 3rd – 20, 4th – 18, 5th – 17, 6th – 16, 7th – 15, 8th – 14, 9th – 13, 10th – 12, 11th – 11, 12th – 10, 13th – 9, 14th – 8, 15th – 7, 16th – 6, 17th – 5, 18th – 4, 19th – 3, 20th – 2 point and all other finishers 1 point. The fastest qualifier at each round shall be allocated one point.

### **1.3 Improved Production Cars over 2000cc Point Score**

*Replaces WASCC Standing Regulation 2 – only for Improved Production Cars*

Points for any Meeting or Series or Championship shall be allocated to the driver for each race that comprises of that Meeting or Series or Championship as follows: 1st – 25 points, 2nd – 22, 3rd – 20, 4th – 18, 5th – 17, 6th – 16, 7th – 15, 8th – 14, 9th – 13, 10th – 12, 11th – 11, 12th – 10, 13th – 9, 14th – 8, 15th – 7, 16th – 6, 17th – 5, 18th – 4, 19th – 3, 20th – 2 point and all other finishers 1 point. The fastest qualifier at each round shall be allocated one point.

## **2 WASCC Championship for Street Cars**

Points for each race will be accumulated and the winner of each class will be the driver with the highest aggregate of points, unless otherwise stated in the WASCC Standing Regulations, these regulations or the meeting Supplementary Regulations.

## **3 State Championship for Street Cars**

*Replaces WASCC Standing Regulations 3.1.3*

Points for each race will be accumulated and the winner of each class will be the driver with the highest aggregate of points after the lowest scoring round of each driver is dropped, ie. the highest six point scoring rounds will be counted. A non-point scoring round can be dropped. A round not entered or contested can be dropped.

The Torque Trophy shall not form part of the State Championship.

Drivers shall accumulate points for Street Car races held at Collie Motorplex as well as Barbagallo Raceway.
